


# QIA RESPONSE TO COVID-19

In mid-March QIA implemented new measures in response to COVID-19 and suspended all regular programs and closed our offices to the public. Our staff's efforts were re-directed to design new emergency initiatives. On March 30, QIA rolled out two initiatives to assist Qikiqtani Inuit during the COVID-19 pandemic including food vouchers for Elders and emergency funding for Qikiqtani families to social distance on-the-land and harvest.


The funds for QIA's COVID-19 response plan came from the Indigenous Community Support Fund (ICSF) announced by the Federal Government on March 25, 2020. QIA's share of that fund is approximately \$6.1 million (\$6,132,544).

These initiatives have been a huge success. Our online applications for the on-the-land program were completed quickly. Families expressed their gratitude and sent photos and messages from successful on-the-land trips from across the Qikiqtani Region. Elders have told us that the grocery vouchers made a big difference in their lives – giving them regular access to necessary household goods.

COVID-19 has greatly impacted how we conduct ourselves, at work and at home. We are acclimatizing to the new normal and are finding alternative ways to deliver our programming while respecting social distancing and public health measures.

QIA continues efforts to increase Inuit employment throughout the Qikiqtani Region with Tuttarvik, our online labour database, and the Qikiqtani Skills Training for Employment Partnership (Q-STEP). Tuttarvik connects Inuit to employment, education and skill development opportunities while Q-STEP provides Inuit the training needed for jobs in emerging sectors like mining. Q-STEP is funded partly by the Government of Canada's Skills and Partnership Fund.

On August 14, 2019, the Government of Canada formally acknowledged and apologized for modern-day colonial practices imposed on Inuit in the Qikiqtani Region between 1950 and 1975, such as forced relocations, family separation, and killing of qimmiit.

Along with this apology was a signing of a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) and a promise of a renewed partnership towards positive change.

To date, the Federal Government has pledged \$20 million to the Qikiqtani Inuit Association for work related to the Qikiqtani Truth Commission. Negotiations to reach our financial goal have been impacted by COVID-19.

QIA's work on initiatives related to the Qikiqtani Truth Commission have also been impacted by COVID-19, with the closure of our offices and programs from mid-March to mid-June.



### QC FISHERIES RESEARCH VESSEL

The QC Fisheries Division has been collaborating with Qikiqtani communities to advance inshore fisheries development across our Region. QC has invested \$2.5 million in a multi-purpose research vessel. The construction of this vessel was completed in June 2020.

The vessel will be used as a platform to train community members in inshore marine research, with the objective to have Nunavummiut lead and conduct future research activities.


With this state-of-the-art research vessel Qikiqtani Inuit will have the resources they need to initiate local inshore fisheries supporting a conservation economy and creating local economic opportunities.

The research vessel has been named RV Ludy Pudluk in honour of the late Ludy Pudluk who served on the QC Board for over two decades. Pudluk was a strong advocate for creating opportunities for community economic development and was dedicated to advancing the inshore fishery in the Qikiqtani Region.




